1. TEN SAFETY FOR STUDENT EXCURSIONS TO A WATER MANAGEMENT FACILITY

- 2. Entry only with consent:** You can only enter the building with the permission of the manager or administrator and you must always be accompanied by an employee of the operator who will take care of your safety.
- 3. Protective Equipment:** Each student must have sturdy shoes and clothing that allows for comfortable movement and is appropriate for the weather and terrain. If additional protective equipment is needed, such as a helmet, reflective vest and safety glasses, they will be provided to you and an employee of the operator will check that you have everything correctly fitted.
- 4. Risk Awareness:** Before entering, we will familiarize you with potential risks and important information such as emergency exits and first aid locations. Confirm that you have understood everything with your signature.
- 5. Entry to premises:** You may not enter any premises without the knowledge and presence of an employee of the operator. We warn you in advance of dangerous places, such as areas with dangerous gases.
- 6. Hazard reporting:** Report any accident, defect or dangerous situation immediately to the operator's staff. Also let him know if you feel uncomfortable due to noise, dust or other conditions.
- 7. Prohibited activities:** You must not approach machines, handle technical devices or touch chemicals. It is also forbidden to enter prohibited areas and pour dangerous substances into the sewers.
- 8. Safe movement:** Move carefully, watch the surroundings and do not enter the paths of vehicles. Park only in designated areas and observe the maximum speed limit.
- 9. Listening to instructions:** Always listen to the instructions of the operator employee accompanying you. Do not leave him without his consent and respect the instructions of the security personnel.
- 10. Liability for property:** The operator is not responsible for your personal belongings. If you do not follow the rules, damage may occur for which the operator is not responsible.

Use of protective equipment: Always use assigned protective equipment and follow safety signage. In this way, you protect not only yourself, but also others around you.
